What can we do for you as your medical home?

A medical home is made up of a team of healthcare professionals that provide a range of services, working together to care for your unique health needs. Providing you with the best medical care possible is the goal of the medical home. At PHS we have teams of doctors, nurses, nutritionists, behaviorists, pharmacists and more to come alongside and partner with you on your health journey.

What is evidence-based care?

When you are not feeling well, your PHS provider is here to help you get better. To do this, we take a very patient-centered approach to the care we give by practicing what is called evidenced-based medicine.



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What does this even mean?

It is a way of caring for our patients that involves listening closely to you. We want to know your health-related goals and worries. We then look at the proof found in research articles and the advice from groups such as the American Heart Association, and add in our own know-how. At the end, we come up with a plan TOGETHER ... one that can help you feel your best.

How do school-based health centers work?

School-based Health Centers offer a unique form of care by serving entire school districts with fully integrated dental, medical, vision, and behavioral health services all in one location. These school districts provide transportation to students to and from the health center during the work day so parents aren't missing work and students aren't missing as much classroom time. These centers are also able to provide services to the school district staff and community at large.

In order to receive School-based services, and school transportation, parents will need to fill out the SBHC consent packet. Students will not be able to receive services unless a consent packet is on file.

Need to see someone in the evening or weekend? Try Express Care!

If your Provider is full or it's after hours, no need to worry. We have you covered with Express Care.

Express Care is walk-in or by appointment with our offices offering acute services. No appointment is necessary and patients are seen on a first come first served basis. A board-certified Family Nurse Practitioner (FNP) may see all patients and evaluate for treatment.

Express Care providers are able to evaluate and treat minor conditions and facilitate a follow up appointment with the individual's primary care provider. Express Care can order X-Rays, lab/blood draws and perform some minor procedures.

Express Care is open 7 days a week 11am - 9pm at our Hamilton West, Middletown Verity, and Dayton locations.
