



THE 8 STEPS TO UNDERSTANDING OUR SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH SERVICES

Welcome to Primary Health Solutions (PHS) School-Based Health Center. The School-Based Health Center, operated by PHS at participating school districts, brings medical, dental, behavioral health and vision care services to students during the school day and beyond.

- 1 The School Based Health Consent packet must be completed in its entirety
- 2 Turn in the completed packet to the school nurse or at the health center
- 3 Once the completed consent packet is received, we will begin appointments for approved services
- 4 You will receive a notice of the appointment time by phone or note from school. If we do not receive a request to change the appointment, we will proceed as scheduled
- 5 Parents & guardians are welcome at appointments, but are not required to be there
- 6 The school will provide transportation from school, to the health center for appointments, and back to school, including the schools where the health center is located on site. Consent for transportation must be on file if parents/guardians will not be taking students to appointments
- 7 A Patient Plan will be sent home in a sealed envelope after each visit
